Île aux Cerfs (Deer Island) Mauritius

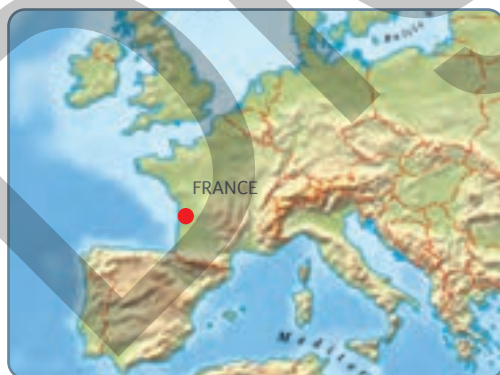

**Grosse Cloche
Bordeaux, France**

This Gothic belfry was built on 13th-century protective ramparts and later served as both a prison and the bell tower of the nearby Hôtel de Ville. It was originally one of six gates into the city. In 1759 a clock was installed above the gate. The huge bell dating from 1775 weighs 7,750kg and peals monthly and on special occasions. It is crowned by two conical towers, which remain of the original six.

**Jikkokubune, Fushimi
Kyoto, Japan**

The canals of Fushimi were constructed to facilitate the transportation of goods, particularly sake, which Fushimi is famous for, with its numerous breweries. Beautiful cherry blossom can be viewed along the canals in a serene trip in one of the jikkokubune, the traditional flat-bottomed canal boats, which carried goods and people from the late 1500s when Fushimi developed as the main port for Kyoto.

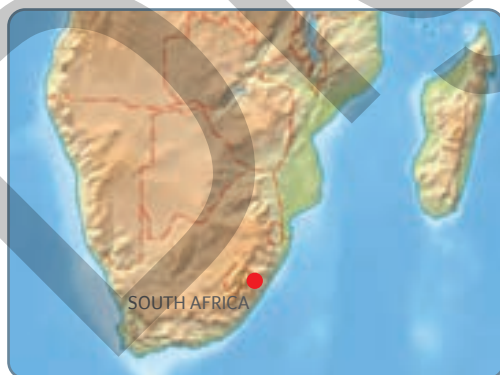

**Drakensberg Mountains
South Africa**

The Drakensberg escarpment extends over 1,000km in eastern South Africa. Meaning 'Dragon Mountains' in Afrikaans, they are the country's highest mountains, up to 3,482m in height. It is a place of rugged beauty made up of plateaus, peaks, cliffs and deep valleys. There are many game reserves and parks in the region and ancient rock paintings of the San people adorn many of the caves and cliff faces.

**Chicago River
Chicago, USA**

This system of rivers and canals with a length of 156 miles runs through downtown Chicago past forest preserves and parks, urban and suburban communities. Crucial in Chicago's industrial development in the 19th century, it originally flowed into Lake Michigan but after a severe storm in 1885 it was engineered in 1900 to reverse its flow out of the lake instead of into it by using a series of canal locks.

**Kuang Si Falls
nr. Luang Prabang, Laos**

This large three-tiered cascade tumbles 50m from the thick jungle above, over white limestone rocks into perfectly sculpted limestone pools below, perfect for swimming, surrounded by lush tropical rainforest. In the dry season minerals such as copper in the water give it a turquoise blue hue. The waterfall is situated in northern central Laos near Luang Prabang, known for its many Buddhist temples.

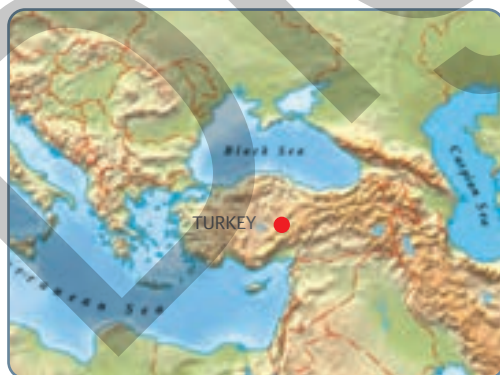

**Love Valley, Göreme National Park
Cappadocia, Turkey**

In a spectacular volcanic landscape, entirely sculpted by erosion, the Göreme area is known for its breathtaking rock formations. The landscape consists of high plateaus, lunar-like boulders and rocky pillars called 'fairy chimneys'. It is the location for human dwellings, troglodyte villages and underground towns, dating from the 4th century, with underground churches richly decorated with Byzantine art.

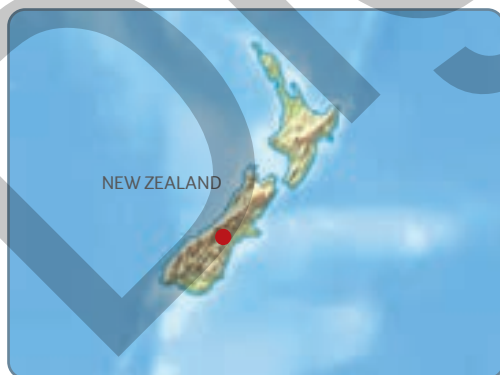

**Tekapo Lake
South Island, New Zealand**

This beautiful lake in the dramatic Southern Alps gets its intense milky-turquoise colour from the fine rock-flour (ground by glaciers), suspended in the water. It is also known for its seasonal display of lupins that bloom along its shores, introduced in the Mackenzie Basin in the 1940s and the slopes of the Roundhill Ski Area. Lake Tekapo is famous for its clear nights and lack of light pollution.

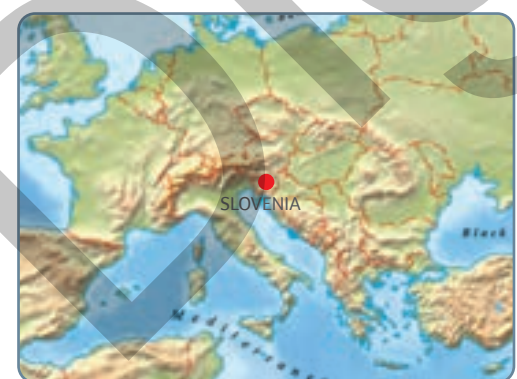

Jamnik Kranj, Slovenia
 The small village of Jamnik on the Jelovica Plateau is renowned for its stunning views and the picturesque church of St. Primus and Felician, perched on top of a hill with a superb panorama of the mountainous landscape of the Julian Alps, the Kamnik-Savinja Alps and the Ljubljana Basin. The white church, at an altitude of 831m, surrounded by forested hillsides, has inspired many photographers.

Fjaðrárgljúfur Canyon Iceland

This spectacular canyon has a unique serpent-like shape. It is 100m deep and 2km long, with sheer walls dotted with many waterfalls. It was formed over millions of years by progressive erosion caused by water flowing from glaciers through the rocks on the Fjaðrá River which still flows through it today. A waterfall flows down the western side of the canyon, visible from an observation platform.

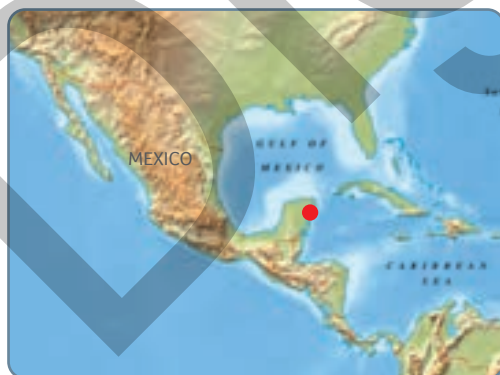

Tulum Mexico

The Mayan ruins are dramatically situated on 12m-high cliffs along the east coast of the Yucatán Peninsula on the Caribbean coast. Tulum was one of the last cities inhabited by the Maya and flourished between the 13th and 15th centuries. The most picturesque structure is Templo del Dios del Viento (Temple of the God of Winds), perched on a rocky outcrop overlooking the beach of fine white sand.

Nordland, Norway**

A Northern Lights display over this scenic fishing village with its striking backdrop of Reinefjorden and steep mountains rising from the sea. It lies above the Arctic Circle on the island of Moskenesøya in the Lofoten Archipelago and consists of several small islands, dotted with red fishermen's houses, all linked by bridges. It has been a trading post since 1743 and a centre for the local fishing industry.
